

DISABLED VETERAN EXEMPTION



Are you a disabled veteran?

- ✓ Can you provide an official document stating you were “honorably discharged” from military services
- and**
- ✓ have a service-connected disability of 10% or more
- with**
- ✓ a current homestead exemption in Lake County?

If you are a veteran or an unmarried surviving spouse and meet ALL the requirements above, you may qualify for one of three available exemptions that could provide significant savings on your annual property tax bill.

Exemption Amount	\$5000 of value reduced	Value reduced based on percentage of veteran's disability rating	Exempt from all ad valorem taxes

If you are a deployed service member on active duty outside the continental United States, Alaska, or Hawaii in support of a qualified military operation, please contact our office, as you may be eligible to receive an additional exemption based on the number of days deployed.
